

Course Description:

This course is designed for all health and social care staff working alongside children and young people. This course will increase awareness regarding the physical, cognitive, emotional and social development of the child and young person, guiding you through the development cycle, to give greater insight into the growing child. Training packages can be tailored to meet the specific needs and concerns of your service.

Duration:

The session is delivered over one day. Training times are normally 9.30-16.30.

Course content:

Codes of Practice; Developmental stages; Domains of development; Theories of child development; Attachment theory; Secure and Insecure attachment; Needs of the child; Growth and development 0-3; Nature v Nurture; Play; Growth and development 4-10; Exploring; Practising; Pretending; Social Learning; Adolescence 11-18

Certification:

Delegates will receive a certificate of attendance on completing the course.
