

Course Description:

This course will give the participants re-qualification at the highest level of First Aid, meeting the statutory requirements of the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations (1981).

Duration:

A minimum of 12 hours spread over at least 2 days. Ideally consecutive days, however we have the flexibility to accommodate your specific needs.

Course content includes:

Legalities, responsibilities and reporting; Dealing with an unresponsive casualty, Shock; Anaphylaxis; Resuscitation; Head injuries; Chest injuries; Asthma; Bandaging; Strains and sprains; Assessment of situation; Fractures and spinal injuries; Control of bleeding; Heart attacks; Eye injuries; Epilepsy; Choking; Poisoning; Burns; Infection control.

Certification:

Subject to assessment, all delegates will be issued with an FAW certificate approved by the HSE. It is valid for a further 3 years.

Numbers:

A maximum of 12 delegates can be accommodated on this course. Each delegate must have a valid FAW qualification that has not lapsed by more than 28 days.

Location:
