

Course Description:

If your assessment of First Aid needs highlights the requirement for qualified First Aiders, then this course will provide you with suitable, highly trained personnel. This course will give the participants a qualification at the highest level of First Aid, meeting the statutory requirements of the Health and Safety (First Aid) Regulations (1981).

Duration:

A minimum of 18 hours spread over at least 3 days. Ideally consecutive days, however we have the flexibility to accommodate your specific needs.

Course content includes:

Legalities; Infection control; Dealing with an unresponsive casualty, Shock; Anaphylaxis; Resuscitation; Head injuries; Chest injuries; Asthma; Bandaging; Strains and sprains; Assessment of situation; Fractures and spinal injuries; Control of bleeding; Heart attacks; Eye injuries; Epilepsy; Choking; Poisoning; Burns

Certification:

Subject to assessment, all delegates will be issued with an FAW certificate approved by the HSE. It is valid for 3 years and can be renewed by attending a 2 day re-qualification course. The HSE recommends all First Aiders also attend an annual refresher.

Numbers: A maximum of 12 delegates can be accommodated on this course.

Location:

NB: Students must be a minimum of 14 and a certificate can be offered to all, subject to assessment. A student cannot claim an official role as First Aider in the workplace until they are 16, dependent on the employer's assessment of suitability for the role.
