The home has a separate kitchen, laundry room, dining room and communal lounge. Each resident has their own bedroom, with en-suite facilities.



Manor Farm is situated in 16 acre grounds in the village of Abbotsley on the outskirts of St Neots. It is within easy distance of all major amenities which include a bowling alley, museum, library, local parks, local shops, and pubs. Manor Farm is also within five minutes distance of the railway station and London Kings Cross can be reached by train in 45 minutes.

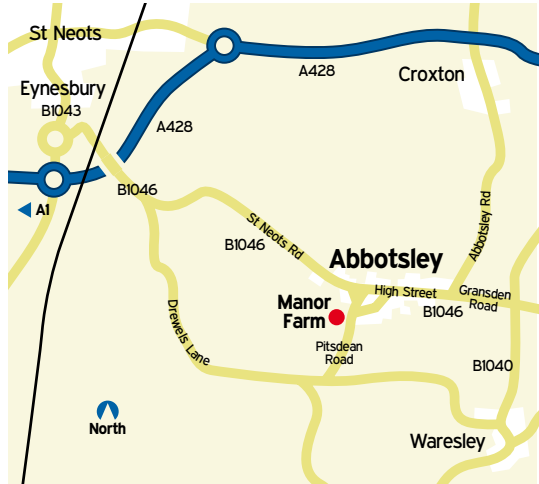

### Directions

From A1 Northbound and Southbound leave the A1 at the A428 turn off (Cambridge). At the roundabout follow signs for Cambridge. At the next roundabout, take the first exit (you will see a Tesco store on your left). Go straight over the next two small roundabouts.

At the main roundabout, take the second exit signed Abbotsley, B1046. Proceed to the traffic lights where you need to turn right. Follow the road for two miles and you will enter Abbotsley. Once in Abbotsley village, take the first turning on the right – Pittsdean Road. Manor Farm is situated 200 yds on your right.
