Sheridan House is a nine-bedded residence situated in Bedfordshire. It is a specialist unit for young adults who have a diagnosis of Autistic Spectrum Disorder with associated learning disability and challenging behaviour.

At Sheridan House we champion the rights and interests of all people with autism and aim to provide the residents with advice, help and support to enable them to access activities and services which will make a positive difference to their lives.

We encourage independence skills, including support with cooking, and daily tasks around the home. Each resident at Sheridan House has a care plan programme which identifies their needs and capabilities allowing staff to encourage and support the service users to work towards gaining new skills with the opportunity to move onto more independent services.
